NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN STEERING GROUP DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST – updated 6 July 2020

In accordance with clause 6 of the Terms of Reference, all members of the BCPNPSG must declare any potential conflict of interest that might impact the Neighbourhood Planning process or outcome.

These declarations will be made available for public scrutiny on request to the Town Clerk at Battle Town Council.

Potential conflict of interest might arise from (but is not limited to)

- Land ownership, where there is the potential for development of 2 or more additional dwellings or where the member lives adjacent to an area identified within the sites for consideration
- Share ownership, where a significant number of shares (over £100,000 cash value) are held in a company known to have a developer interest in the Neighbourhood Area.
- Employment status, if a member is employed by or works for a company instructed by developers involved in the development of land in the parish of Battle

In the event that a matter of 'interest' should arise during the course of developing the plan then the Member should bring it to the attention of the Steering Group, and any working group the member participates in at the next meeting of the BCPNPSG under the relevant agenda item.

Any matters of interest identified will not preclude a member from participating in the development of the Neighbourhood Plan. It is simply a declaration of potentially competing interests, and to promote the objectivity of the persons involved. This ensures transparency and honesty throughout the process.
